

#### **Paddy Cultivation Southern Province 2017 - 2023**





# Paddy Average Yield (Mt/Ha) Southern Province 2018 - 2023




### **Crop Cultivation Southern Province**





Percentage of Population Engaged in Agriculture **Southern Province (%)** 











#### Number of Maternal and Child mortality Southern Province 2017- 2021



#### Crude Birth Rate 2017 - 2023










#### **Dengue Incidence Rate in Southern Province-2020**




## Hospitalizations, Hospital Deaths and Case Fatality Rates Of Diabetes Southern Province -2020












### Annual Income of DMT (Rs. Million) 2017 - 2023




# Tourist Guests Night in Southern Province 2017 - 2020

### Revenue Earned by Local Government Authorities in Southern Province 2017 – 2023 (Rs. Mn)











## G.C.E A/L Passed percentage 2017-2023




Literacy Rate By Year 2017 -2023






## Sea Fish Production- Southern Province (2017 – 2023) Mt

## **Average Daily Egg Production 2017-2023**







#### **Inland and Aquatic Fish Production 2017 - 2023**














#### **Number of Rural Development Societies and Members 2017-2023**




## Number Of Children in Orphanages 2017 - 2023



## Number of Sports Clubs Empowered 2020 - 2022




